

**Stone Mountain Park - Group Campsites for Scouts
Rules & Regulations
Cherokee Trail & Campsites, Inc.**

1. All rules and principles of Stone Mountain Park, Boy Scouts of America, Girl Scouts of America, and Leave No Trace Program are applicable to these campsites, though the sites are not necessarily affiliated with these organizations.
2. Arrive no later than 10 PM of your first reserved date; plan on leaving the campsite(s) no later than 1PM on your departure day.
3. Allow the gate attendant to direct you to the Public Safety office on the Stone Mountain Park Grounds. You can pick up the key to the group site parking lot gate there. PLEASE RETURN THE KEY TO THE SAME OFFICE UPON YOUR DEPARTURE. The phone number for the Public Safety office at Stone Mountain Park is (770) 413-5333.
4. Any pertinent information regarding your stay will be posted in the parking lot area.
5. It is recommended that you re-lock the gate after all of your party's vehicles are parked to prevent unauthorized use of the parking area.
6. You may utilize the road to bring your equipment in close proximity to your campsite; once your vehicles are unloaded, please return them to the designated parking area so that the road can remain clear.
7. Please apply Leave No Trace Principles to minimize impact of the fragile habitats of Stone Mountain: please use designated fire rings only and do not build structures in the sites or dam up the stream. Do not use the stream or lake for cleaning or for disposal of food. Either bring in your own firewood or collect deadfall. Firewood is available for purchase at the RV Campground store.
8. Wear shoes at all times! This area of the lake is often used for fishing!
9. Remain on marked and established trails throughout your visit.
10. Use established campsites only.

Refer to the Stone Mountain Brochure produced by Cherokee Trail & Campsites for information on hiking the Cherokee Historic Trail, earning patches and medals for your Scouts, and a list of Scout Requirements (Boy and Girl Scouts) that can be fulfilled during your stay at Stone Mountain.

Upon Departure:

1. Extinguish all fires.
2. Thoroughly police grounds and restroom areas for trash.
3. Make sure all faucets are off
4. Inspect bathrooms
5. Carry trash up to the parking lot and place in the bins provided. Recycle if possible.
6. Lock the gate when the last car has vacated the parking lot.
7. Return the key to the Public Safety Office and list any problems you may have had with the facilities.
